Got soy wax? Got dye? Put the two together in exciting combinations, including crayons perfect for rubbings, drawing and writing; hot, colored wax - ideal for stamping and direct applications and wax paste, perfect for stenciling. Soy wax is biodegradable and a renewable resource. When combined with fiber reactive dyes the results are fabulous - intricate patterns with the staying power of the dyes and an ease of wash-out unmatched by other resists. We'll begin our three day exploration with a demonstration of crayon and hot wax techniques. Then we'll jump right in to open lab time for experimentation with rubbings and stamping. Additional lectures focus on building and using a steamer, ideas for incorporating techniques into other surface design processes, and an end of weekend show and tell.
